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AHRQ CAHPS Database Overview

Databases are for selected CAHPS surveys



- Two major applications:
 - Facilitates comparisons of patient experiences
 - De-identified data for research

AHRQ CAHPS Database Overview



- Participation is voluntary, free and open to all users of surveys supported by the Database
- Annual cycle of submissions and reporting
- Submitters complete a Data Use Agreement (DUA) which assures data privacy and protection
- Results are de-identified so no participating organization's data are ever publicly reported



Child HCAHPS Survey Database



- Free and open to all users of the Child HCAHPS Survey
 - Free standing, self-governing children's hospitals
 - Children's hospitals within a hospital
 - Pediatric units within a hospital
- Completed second year of data submission and reporting; inaugural year (2022) was the pilot year

Why Participate in the Child HCAHPS Database?



 Each participating hospital receives a free private feedback report comparing their results to the Database




- De-identified research data files available for approved research projects

Released October 2023



8,107 survey responses voluntarily submitted by 35 hospitals.

of respondents reported that doctors always listened carefully, explained things clearly, and treated parents with courtesy and respect.




85%

2023 CAHPS Child Hospital Database Child and Respondent Characteristics



Child Characteristics		Respondent Characteristics		
Þ	47% were female		87% were the mother of the child	
	28% were less than one year old		42% were between the ages of 35-44	



70% were in Very Good or Excellent health, as reported by respondents



56% had a fouryear college degree or more

Analyses by Selected Characteristics





Length of Stay: For the majority of measures, a longer length of stay is associated with lower patient experience scores.



Age of Child: Patient experience scores tend to be higher for children over one year old.

Survey administration period is between


